## Meeting called to order

The meeting was called to order at 10:07 a.m. A quorum was confirmed. Commissioner Martinez was absent with notice.

## **Approval of Minutes**

Commissioner Masters moved to approved the meeting minutes, both open and closed, from the January 22, 2018 meeting. Commissioner Townsend seconded, and the motion was approved by voice vote.

## **Executive Director's Report**

- A. Report on sale of properties- Mr. Anderson discussed property sales with his written report. Of note, Mr. Anderson stated there are approximately 65 houses left in the Land Bank, and those will likely be gone in a month or two. A copy is available in the Land Bank Offices. For information only, no vote was taken.
- B. Publicity/Engagements- Mr. Anderson discussed publicity Land Bank has garnered since the last meeting, which consisted of an on-air story on Channel 41. The story concerned a finished house and two houses in various stages of completion by Gabe Gillen. For information only, no vote was taken.
- C. Mr. Anderson discussed Board appointments. Commissioner Martinez's term has been renewed for another term. For information only, no vote was taken.
- D. Mr. Anderson discussed the recent KCStat meeting, put on by the City's office of performance management. The City Manager and Mayor are both pleased with the Land Bank's performance. The Manager stated that he is hearing from his peers in local government circles that Kansas City has the highest-performing Land Bank in the Country. Mr. Anderson showed the Commissioners the graph he presented at the

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meeting, showing the strong trend over the last 5 years of Land Bank selling more and more property, while taking in fewer and fewer properties. This year Land Bank projections are to sell 479 properties and take in around 125 properties. For information only, no vote was taken.

### **Guest Speakers**

Kimiko Gilmore talked about urban agriculture in Kansas City. It was discussed and decided at the meeting that Ms. Gilmore would help Mr. Anderson develop procedures for applicants who wish to developer urban farms and gardens.

Brittan Motley discussed the application his group has in for an option agreement in the Washington Wheatley neighborhood. They intend to build new houses. Marlon Hammonds, President of Washington Wheatley was also here to state the Neighborhood is in favor of the proposed development. Mr. Motley states there is funding in place from Family First Funding.
